



Code of Conduct for Parents and Visitors at Forrest Parade School

To assist the school in providing a safe and positive educational environment, all parents and visitors are expected to:

- recognise and respect the authority of the school principal and the school council
- comply with all relevant laws, regulations, policies, and procedures
- observe confidentiality in respect of all information gained through participation in school activities. Respect the privacy of all members of the Forrest Parade community
- observe the department's zero-tolerance approach to occupational violence and not behave in ways that a reasonable person would consider to be offensive, intimidating, humiliating, aggressive, threatening or abusive
- respect and adhere to the established lines of communication. Please speak with the class teacher first. If you require further clarification contact a member of the leadership team and then contact the Department of Education
- not harass, victimise or discriminate against any person on the basis of personal attributes, e.g., disability, age, gender, race, religion, political affiliation, marital status, sexual preference
- comply with the school's access procedure. Parents/carers will be escorted through the school. Access to an entry fob will not be permitted
- if making public comment (through the media or otherwise) on political and social issues, make it clear that the comments are made in a private capacity and do not represent the official view of the school, or the department
- abide by the schools Facebook Guidelines that are as follows:

The Facebook page is intended to be a useful exchange of information regarding Forrest Parade School and a celebration of our student's achievements.

Any content that is considered to be offensive will be deleted immediately. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Profane, defamatory or offensive language
- Posting deliberately disruptive statements meant to hijack comment threads or throw discussions off-track
- Attacks on specific groups or any comments meant to harass, threaten or abuse an individual
- Hateful or discriminatory comments regarding race, ethnicity, religion, gender, disability, sexual orientation or political beliefs
- Content determined to be inappropriate, in poor taste, or otherwise contrary to the purposes of the forum
- behave with respect and courtesy, even when disagreeing with someone or something

Any posts that do not comply with these guidelines will be deleted.

Users who violate these guidelines will be blocked.
